Register: This week's scheduled Register will be sent to you next Friday, March 29, 2019. The issue will be a special report that includes the list of substantiated allegations of diocesan clergy abuse of minors. The March 29 Register will also include the Capuchin O.F.M.'s list of credible allegation of clergy abuse of minors.

Listening Session: I, along with Fr. Christopher Popravak, Provincial of Capuchins O.F.M. of the Province of St. Concord, are holding a Listening Session on April 2 at 7:00PM at St. Nicholas of Myra Parish in Hays. We will use this time to address any questions or concerns parishioners may have following the release of the special report of clergy who have abused minors within the Salina Diocese. I encourage you to attend the event. If you are unable to attend, we will be recording the Listening Session and will place it on the Salina Diocese website at a later date.
