



Diocese of Salina- Safe Environment Training Instructions for High School Students (Grades 9-12) working/volunteering with children.

## **Getting Started:**

➤ The Safe Environment training platform can be accessed at the Diocese of Salina's webpage <a href="http://salinadiocese.org">https://salina.CMGConnect.org</a>. It is recommended to use Google Chrome for full functionality. Register for a **New Account** by completing the required boxes. First name, last name, set up a username and password (that you will remember). Address, city, state, zip, phone number, email (suggested, but not required), and date of birth. Primary school/parish, your role in the school/parish (please select **Volunteer**), and how you participate in your school or parish(please select **Youth Minors**(training course for minors between 9th and 12th grades who volunteer with other children.)







➤ Once you have completed everything, click the to return to the main menu.

When you finish the training **PLEASE NOTIFY** the Safety Coordinator of your school or parish (or the person who instructed you to do this training) so they can notify the Diocese that you have completed the training and then they will certify you in the database, once this is completed you are ready to begin your ministry.
