ORDINATION AND INSTALLATION - You will have all received an invitation to the Ordination and Installation of Bishop-elect Vincke. Please complete the RSVP you received and fax or email your response to chancery2@salinadiocese.org OR register online at <http://salinadiocese.org/home/ordination-information>. Please submit your completed RSVP by **AUGUST 1st**. Please read the following *very carefully*, as there is important information with regard to the upcoming Ordination and Installation of our new Bishop.

- **Invitations for Parishioners:** Due to *extremely limited seating*, each **pastor of a parish(es)** will receive **4 individual tickets TOTAL**. Even if you are a pastor with multiple parishes, you will still only receive a total of **4 individual tickets**. You may invite 4 guests of your choosing to the following:

- Ordination (Sacred Heart Cathedral – **August 22nd** at 2:00 p.m.)
- Following reception (Hilton Garden Inn – **August 22nd** at approx. 4:00-6:15p.m.)

An email was sent out with a form that included all of the ***required information*** needed by the Bishop's Office. Please return the form to the Chancery by **August 1st**. It is necessary that my secretaries have the names of your guests by August 1st in order to ensure that there will be enough seating. ***If my secretaries do not receive this required information, they will be unable to provide a ticket to your guests. If your guests do not receive a ticket, they will be unable to attend the Ordination.***

- **VESPERS:** Vespers is for CLERGY ONLY, and will take place on **Tuesday, August 21st, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in Sacred Heart Cathedral**. Please wear your black suits to this event. Immediately following Vespers, a group photo of Salina Clergy and Bishop-elect will be taken by Karen Bonar inside the Cathedral. After the photo, there will be a reception hosted by the Cathedral ladies in the Hall of Bishops. Food and drink will be served.
- **ORDINATION:** The Ordination and Installation Mass of Bishop-elect Vincke will take place on **Wednesday, August 22nd, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. in Sacred Heart Cathedral**. All priests will vest in the old Parish Hall. An email from the Office of the Bishop was sent out on July 4th to all the priests with regard to additional vestments. If you still have your older diocesan chasuble, please consider bringing it to Vespers the night before Ordination to lend it to a visiting priest. I encourage you to write your name on the label

- **7:30 p.m.** – Dinner at the Hilton Garden Inn for Bishop-elect, his family and friends, all remaining clergy, and diocesan employees

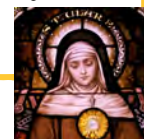

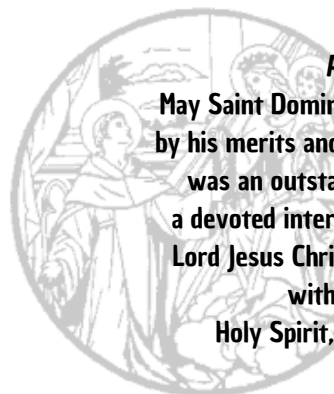
