We are in the process of scheduling dates for **on-site audit visits to Parishes and Schools** (Year 3, West Central Deanery and St. Mary School-Ellis, Holy Family- Hays, TMP- Hays and Sacred Heart, Plainville) and for anyone else who has not had a visit from us during this 3-year cycle. Earlier this month, I sent out an email asking for possible dates that would work for each of you, as I know many of you hold full time jobs along with being the Safety Coordinator of your parish/school. If you have not responded to that email, please contact me as soon as possible so I can start putting together the master schedule. As soon as I hear back from everyone I will move forward and get your dates and times emailed to you along with a tentative agenda and checklist of things we will be looking for when we come to your parish/school as it pertains to the Safe Environment Program. Thank you for your cooperation. We look forward to meeting you!

TESTIMONY OF COMPLIANCE FORM-Safe Environment training for STUDENTS (Child Lures etc...) must be returned to the Diocese (Wendy Backes 103 N. Ninth Salina, KS 67401) **by January 1, 2019**. Copies of this form were mailed out in August in your Safe Environment Packet. Copies can also be downloaded from our website.

Thank you to all of the Safety Coordinators in the Diocese who are all diligently getting their new volunteers and employees trained and into the CMGConnect data base. Safety Coordinators of Parishes and Schools, if you have **not** returned your Certification Status sheet, or information sheet, please do so as soon as possible so those can be verified and filed. Please be sure you send me the names of high school students (9-12) who are doing/have done the HS training so I can certify them in the database.

Kidsmartz is a child safety program, similar to Child Lures that educates families about preventing abduction and empowers kids in grades K-5 to practice safer behaviors. This program offers resources to help parents, caregivers, and teachers protect kids by teaching and practicing the 4 Rules of Personal Safety using tips, printable activities, quizzes, music, video and more. This program was created by the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children. If you are still looking for ideas to implement into your curriculum to fulfill the Safe Environment training for student's requirement of the https://www.kidsmartz.org/ Diocese of Salina, please check out this website. All you have to do is log in, it is FREE and the materials/lesson plans are right there!

Another resource if you haven't completed your Testimony of Compliance Form, is fairly new. It is called "**Protect Yourself Rules**" and is provided free of charge through the Barbara Sinatra Children's Foundation. More information can be found at www.fightchildabuse.org.

Please be mindful of those as our safe environment programs are in place to assist parents and children—and those who work with children in securing a safe environment for our young people where they can grow to full and human Christian maturity.

#iGiveCatholic

By the time you read this, #iGiveCatholic on #GivingTuesday (November 27) will be over. Because of you who shared your stories on the www.salinaigivecatholic.org page, the Salina Diocese will receive over \$250,000 in gifts to the organizations that shape the souls of our faithful: parishes, schools and ministries. (\$250,000 is a conservative estimate, since this is being written before the day is over.) Watch your emails for the full details.

Here are a couple items to note as we wrap up this initiative.

When will my organization receive its donations?

The Salina Diocese will send your donations via check within 60 days of the giving day. This check will include all gifts to your organization less the cost to participate (no more than \$150) and the credit card fees (not paid by the donor).

Thank you letters

Donors received an email from #iGiveCatholic confirming their gift. This will be the tax deduction form not necessarily "thank you." By registering to participate in #iGiveCatholic, organizations agreed to acknowledge donations within **seven working days**. Participants may contact donors through any medium they like, including thank you letters, phone calls, or social media "shout outs."

Will my organization receive donor information for acknowledgements?

You will have access to donor information via a donations table that can be accessed in your "Admin Dashboard" and downloaded to a .CSV. (This table was posted on November 27.) To log in to your Admin Dashboard, go to iGiveCatholic.org and click "Menu" in the top right hand corner of the page. A drop down will appear—click "Log In" to enter your email and password.


