OFFICE OF CHANCELLOR

The legal perils of failing to track hours!

Nonprofits/Corporations who don't track how many hours a non-exempt (hourly) employee works are putting their organizations at a real disadvantage. If an employee sues for unpaid overtime, he or she will be able to use inexact estimates as proof of work done but unpaid. What's more, should the employee win the case, those estimated hours end up doubled as punishment.

Case in point: An employee drives small trucks for his employer to various work sites, where he installs or upgrades wireless networks for various tele-communication controller sites. His employer does not track how many hours he worked at a site or whether he might work at more than one site per day.

The employee sues, alleging he had worked more than 1,000 overtime hours for which he had not been paid. He provides his own estimates based on his auto mileage log and emails he had sent to his employer at the beginning and end of work site projects. Because the employer didn't track the employee's hours, the employee's estimates were used.

Conclusion: The employee's estimates were used because the employee didn't track hours as worked by the employee. If the employee's estimates cannot be challenged with good, solid evidence that they are incorrect, they will become the basis for calculating overtime payments due – and then possibly doubled as the statutory penalty allows.

THE LESSON: Please have non-exempt (hourly) employees track the hours they work each day with as much precision as possible. Please take the time to review employee's time sheets frequently to ensure the time sheets are accurate. Furthermore, keep employees' time sheets for three (3) years.

OFFICE OF LITURGY

WEDDING MUSIC CLARIFICATION: There is some confusion about the opening song at weddings. The ritual says that the entrance chant “takes place,” or an opening hymn may be sung. The absolute minimum is that the entrance antiphon should be “recited” by the whole assembly. The intention of the ritual is that the entrance chant should be chanted (sung). This is the intention of the Roman Missal for every Mass. For daily Masses we often minimize that by reciting it, but on Sundays we have replaced it with an opening hymn because it was decided that this was a more feasible option for most parishes. Roman Missal III has elevated the Nuptial Mass to the level of “feast,” which means that it has a Gloria and the entrance chant should be sung. This is why, at workshops organized by the USCCB Office of Divine Worship to introduce the revised Rite of Matrimony they simply emphasized that every wedding that follows ritual 1 (with Mass) and 2 (without Mass, between baptized persons) must begin with an opening song, sung by the assembly.

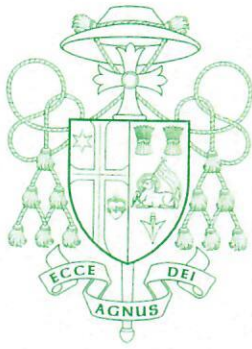

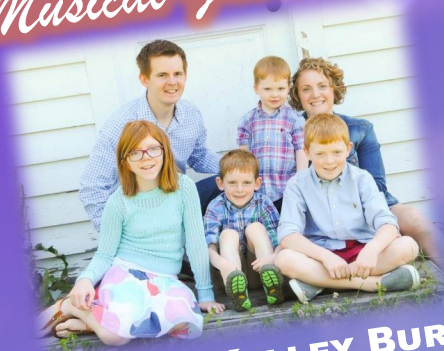
