PROPAGATION OF THE FAITH

2020 MISSION COOPERATIVE PROGRAM: All parishes and mission groups have received a memo from the Salina Propagation of the Faith Office, reminding them of our diocesan policy that pastors and mission groups may negotiate to have the mission cooperative appeal made by the pastor using materials supplied by the mission group. Some groups are making use of this option. Other groups are scheduling in-person presentations by the mission group (as commonly done in the past). <u>Note</u>: please inform the Propagation of the Faith office when the mission appeal in your parish(es) will be made, whether by the mission group or by the pastor. A small number of mission groups are choosing to withdraw from the 2020 Salina Diocesan program altogether. In that case because of the lateness of the season, another group will not be assigned for a mission cooperative appeal in 2020. Please keep in mind the mission cooperative appeals continue to be distinct from World Mission Sunday, observed this year on October 17-18, 2020. Thanks for your help in finding the best way to promote mission awareness in your parish(es).

OFFICE OF SAFE ENVIRONMENT

WE HAVE UPDATED THE NAME OF OUR OFFICE: As many of you are aware, the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People was updated in 2018. To be in compliance with those charter updates, we have been working on revising and amending our policy. As we continue to update and enhance our program, we chose to update the name of the office as well. After considering what we need to provide to protect the faithful in the Diocese of Salina, and researching the websites of many other Diocese, we decided on the name *Safe Environment Office*. We thought it suited our mission perfectly. To find us on the Diocese of Salina website please look under the tab "Offices" and then click on "Safe Environment."

ANNUAL DIOCESAN AUDIT - The Diocese of Salina will again be submitting audit data for 2019-2020 electronically. Next year, StoneBridge Partners will be coming here for our **on-site** audit. It is imperative that all volunteers, employees and educators who have ministered during this audit period (July 1, 2019 - June 30, 2020) are trained and in the data base. If you have not contacted me confirming your site is current, please do so as soon as possible.

POLICY/ PROGRAM REVISIONS – We have been diligently working on revising the Policy for the Protection of Children and Young People as well as updating the documents that go in the *Safe Environment Program* section in the blue Diocesan Handbook, (as promised at our audit training meeting this past spring.) We have not finalized the exact date this information will be going out in the **mail**, but we will keep you updated so you know when to start looking for it.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT INFORMATION PACKET - Safe Environment Program information packets will be mailed/emailed (whichever was your preference) in August. Included in the packet will be all the forms each parish or school is required to complete and return.

Thank you for all you have done to promote the Bishop's Annual Appeal – Call to Share. Together our efforts have generated over \$1.36 million for the Diocese of Salina from 3,168

generous donors. These gifts fund seminarian education, priests' retirement and clergy health, evangelization and ministry as well as education. All of us have been blessed and the results make it possible for the diocese to serve our people and parishes.

Remember "Call to Share" pledges and gifts will be accepted through December 31, 2020. There is still plenty of time to encourage your parishioners to participate. Every family should have the opportunity to give, then they will decide if they can.

#iGiveCatholic

We'll do it again this year. The Diocese of Salina will participate in #iGiveCatholic, where Catholics across the nation participate in Giving Tuesday, which is December 1, 2020. This is an online giving day celebrated annually on the Tuesday after Thanksgiving, Black Friday and Cyber Monday. It kicks off the charitable giving season and brings the Catholic community together to give thanks and give back.

Much generosity was shared with our diocese last year, thru this effort. By the end of the counting period, the Salina Diocese ranked #6 in the nation among all 39 archdioceses and dioceses participating. We raised \$387,395.43 from 514 donors with an average gift of \$753.69. There were 8 Salina organizations in the top 100 national rankings, with Manhattan Catholic Schools ranking #5. Nationally, \$7,461,919.03 was received from 29,531 donors for 1743 ministries. This is the largest single Catholic fundraising effort in the nation. We are proud to do it again.

Every parish, school, and Catholic ministry in our diocese will be invited to participate. Watch your emails this summer for more information and an invitation to join us. In the meantime, Beth is working to secure challenge grants. But better yet, you can assure you have a matching grant by working with the influential donors in your area to tailor a challenge for your parish, school or organization. CARES ACT – Charitable tax benefits: The following is reprinted from last month's SDNB. This includes very timely information that can be shared with your parishioners and supporters. If you have any questions, contact Beth Shearer at beth.shearer@salinadiocese.org.

The federal legislation that created the Payroll Protection Program (PPP) loans has also created several charitable tax benefits for giving. This could make a difference for many of your parishioners as they start to consider their tax consequences, usually later in the year. Note these changes seem to be just for this 2020 tax year. You can start to share the following:

Temporary Universal Charitable Deduction for 2020 Tax Year

This deduction allows taxpayers who do not currently itemize their deductions to claim a charitable deduction for cash donations up to \$300 through December 31. The \$300 cap applies to individuals and married couples equally, i.e., a married couple would not be able to take a \$600 deduction. Donations to donor advised funds and supporting organizations are not eligible for this deduction.

AGI Charitable Deduction Caps Suspended or Increased for 2020 Tax Year

The adjusted gross income (AGI) limits on charitable donations are suspended or increased for cash gifts made by individuals and corporations. The 60% AGI cap for individual taxpayers who itemize has been suspended. Taxpayers who itemize are eligible to take charitable deductions for donations up to 100% of their AGI for the 2020 tax year. The AGI cap for corporations has been increased from 10% to 25% for corporate tax years ending in 2020. Donations to private foundations and donor advised funds are not eligible for the increase or suspension of AGI limits.
