#### BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL - CALL TO SHARE



To date, our diocese has been blessed by the generosity of almost 3000 families to the 2020 Bishop's Annual Appeal. They have given over \$1,277 million to support seminarian education, clergy health and retirement, ministries and education. These gifts provide the funds for the

diocese to serve the parishes and people in our region of Kansas.

Unfortunately, our participation rate continues to be low, currently about 17%. In comparison to other dioceses across the nation, this is at the mid to low point of the range for participation. There remains an opportunity for every parishioner to participate in the diocese. We are all in this together.


There will be several more opportunities for giving:

#### **CARES ACT – Charitable tax benefits**

The federal legislation that created the Payroll Protection Program (PPP) loans has also created several charitable tax benefits for giving. This could make a difference for many of your parishioners as they start to consider their tax consequences, usually later in the year. Note these changes seem to be just for this 2020 tax year. You can start to share the following:

#### Temporary Universal Charitable Deduction for 2020 Tax Year

This deduction allows taxpayers who do not currently itemize their deductions to claim a charitable deduction for cash donations up to \$300 through December 31. The \$300 cap applies to individuals and married couples equally, i.e., a married couple would not be able to take a \$600 deduction. Donations to donor advised funds and supporting organizations are not eligible for this deduction.

#### AGI Charitable Deduction Caps Suspended or Increased for 2020 Tax Year

The adjusted gross income (AGI) limits on charitable donations are suspended or increased for cash gifts made by individuals and corporations. The 60% AGI cap for individual taxpayers who itemize has been suspended. Taxpayers who itemize are eligible to take charitable deductions for donations up to 100% of their AGI for the 2020 tax year. The AGI cap for corporations has been increased from 10% to 25% for corporate tax years ending in 2020. Donations to private foundations and donor advised funds are not eligible for the increase or suspension of AGI limits.

ST ISIDORE'S DAY: Reminder, St Isidore's Day was supposed to be observed in the West Deanery, either Colby or Goodland. Due to the limited number of folks who can currently be present (10 in a worship space & 6 ft. apart), we decided to move the observance to the Cathedral, with Bishop Vincke celebrating the Mass for the Memorial of St Isidore at 11 A.M. We plan to send a live feed out to the diocese via Facebook. Depending on whether or not the "stay home" order has been lifted or not, we may have only 10 folks present at the Mass. If it has been lifted, I am hopeful that all members of the Commission will be present for the Mass, in addition to other folks for the Memorial Mass. Additionally, after Mass, Bishop Vincke will bless a horse, a dog, and probably a calf outside the Cathedral. (There may be other critters to bless as well.) Fr David has recorded for Facebook a blessing of a field in his parish. This will be sent out over Facebook after the Mass. We encourage all pastors celebrate St Isidore's Day with their parishes on May 15<sup>th</sup>. Additionally, Karen Bonar has asked that pastors submit a photo in advance of St Isidore's Day of them blessing either a field or critters to be placed in *The Register* as part of the St Isidore's Day observance. I am hopeful that St Isidore's special role as a patron for Farmers as well as a Patron Saint for the Diocese of Salina will be common knowledge among all the Catholics in the Diocese of Salina following St Isidore's Day 2020.

MINISTERING ONLINE TO MINORS-Due to the Pandemic, we all have been forced to be flexible and creative and to rethink our strategies in our homes, schools, churches and businesses. We truly are in difficult times, but we need to continue to maintain healthy boundaries with those we minister to and do all that we can to ensure safe environments for the minors as well as ourselves(adults) in the Diocese of Salina. I have attached a document for you to use as a guideline when ministering online with minors.

**FREE-** Child/Teen Lures Prevention is providing free temporary digital access to Think First & Stay Safe<sup>TM</sup> and/or Teen Lures TV Newscast<sup>TM</sup> resources for distance learning, from April - June, 2020. Everyone is very concerned about the increased risk of neglect, sexual abuse and exploitation of children while home-bound, and they want parishes and schools to be able to reach students during this National Emergency, so, they have set up a Digital Access page to Think First & Stay Safe and Teen Lures TV Newscast curricula components for use with distance learning:

**PARISH AND SCHOOL-** Audits have been completed for 2020. Thank you again for your flexibility during the planning and executing of those meetings. We found the meetings very beneficial and hope you did as well. Please continue to follow the suggestions and recommendations that were made at or after your audit and keep up with communications from the Diocese. I did send an email to those parishes who were not able to participate (live or via Zoom) in the audit training meetings. Please follow up with the protocol in that email as best you can under the circumstances you are encountering. Please feel free to contact the Office of Safety and Security if you have any questions or concerns. Thank you again for all you do to protect our children.

**A KIND REMINDER-** If you have not sent in your Children's Data Report, please do so as soon as possible. And please continue to send in parish bulletins with Safety and Security announcements. The end of our audit period is quickly approaching, and it is imperative that we have all the data we need from the parishes and schools in the Diocese of Salina.

**POLICY FOR RESPONSE TO ALLEGATIONS OF ABUSE OR MISCONDUCT BY BISHOPS** – On March 16th, the USCCB soft launched a new 3rd party reporting system, the website (www.reportbishopabuse.org) and hotline (800-276-1562) are now fully operational. In conjunction with this new reporting system specifically for Bishops and their equivalents the Bishops of Kansas have adopted a new Policy for Response to Allegations of Abuse or Misconduct by Bishops. The new policy is available on the Diocesan Website and will be added to the Diocesan Policy Manual when other updates are completed later this year.

#### **OFFICE OF SAFETY AND SECURITY (cont.)**

**SUMMER ACTIVITIES** -With summer activities (VBS, Totus Tuus, Prayer and Action etc.) quickly approaching, please be sure all adult volunteers working with minors have completed the Safe Environment Curriculum with integrated background check through CMGConnect.

For students under the age of 18 who will be volunteering with minors, please have them complete the Youth Minors Curriculum ("So you think you can volunteer.") in CMGConnect. These volunteers cannot be the primary supervisors of other minors; they must be working under the supervision of at least two fully trained adults (more trained adults may be necessary depending on group size).

(Due to COVID-19, some of these activities may be cancelled or postponed, please check with event coordinator as to the status of these activities)

**ANNUAL DIOCESAN AUDIT** - The Diocese will have an on-line audit this year. It is essential that all volunteers, employees and educators who have ministered during this audit period (July 1, 2019- June 30, 2020) are trained and in the data base. Safety Coordinators, please remember to check your CMGConnect data base WEEKLY. This must be done so we can keep the data base current. Thank you for your cooperation.

#### **CATHOLIC CHARITIES**

**COVID-19 RELIEF:** Catholic Charities has been able to adapt most all programs and services during this time of social distancing and continues to offer critical services to families in need. Although our supply chain was interrupted for a few weeks, we have been able to secure enough food, hygiene items and diapers to resume distribution through our Mobile Outreach vans and our three offices in Hays, Manhattan, and Salina. We update our services weekly at <a href="https://www.ccnks.org">www.ccnks.org</a> and on social media.

In addition to financial support and distribution of goods, Catholic Charities is focusing on mental health. We offer counseling sessions through a HIPPA compliant video or audio platform and are accepting new counseling clients. We have also added three FREE virtual support groups (see attachment) and continue to accept new mothers in our pregnancy programs.

**BABY BOTTLE CAMPAIGNS:** The Manhattan and Hays area Baby Bottle Campaigns, benefiting Catholic Charities' Pregnancy and Adoption Programs, are typically held in parishes from Mother's Day to Father's Day. Since they are uncertain if mass will resume during that time, the committee volunteers have chosen to move these campaigns to October in celebration of Respect Life Month.

**CATHOLIC CHARITIES ANNUAL FUNDRAISER:** Although the final decision has not been made, we are anticipating that the 15th Annual Fundraiser on Saturday, July 18, will be a virtual event. We are in the process of working with the committee to put together an amazing event. 
