PARISH TAX: Please find enclosed the (blue) Parish Tax Assessment sheet for the period of July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016. The figures used in computing this tax were taken from the most recently submitted reports to the Chancery covering the fiscal year of July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015.

The formula used in figuring the tax was \$11.00 times the number of units (Column "c") plus 0.05 times the ordinary/adjusted income (Column "e").

Column "f" represents the total tax for your parish for the fiscal year July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016. Half of this total tax listed in Column "f" is due now; the other half will be due in February of 2016. Please make your checks payable to the Diocese of Salina, and identify them as "Parish Tax". If we haven't received your Annual Report, your parish tax may be adjusted.





7 Ways To Show Your Kids You Care

- 1. Send a text to your kids just to say "hi" or to tell them that you can't wait to spend time together.
