Safe Environment Training Instructions for Minors (in grades 9-12) ministering with other minors in parish or school setting

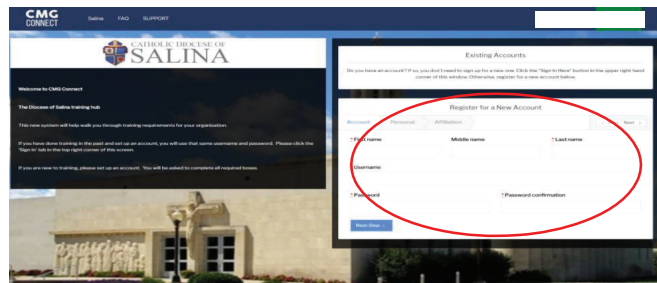
Please note: if you are still in high school but are now 18 years of age, please refer to SE training for adults

To begin on-line training go to salina.cmgconnect.org

Getting Started:

Register for a **New Account** by completing the required boxes. First name, last name, set up a username and password (*that you will remember*). Address, phone number, email- *provide only if you have your own (not shared) email account*, and date of birth. Primary parish/ school, your role in the parish/school and how you participate in your parish or school, please select: **Youth Minors**

IF you have already taken CMG training in the past you will already have an account and you can sign-in with that same username and password. **If you forgot your username or password or are RENEWING, please contact your parish/school safety coordinator.**



Once you have completed all 3 registration screens, your required training will pop up. Begin the required training by clicking
