PROPAGATION OF THE FAITH

2019 MISSION CO-OP - If your parish has not yet sent to the diocese the Mission Cooperative collection from summer 2019, please do so at your earliest convenience. Your prompt attention to this will help avoid confusion of the (summer) 2019 Mission Co-Op collection with the (October) World Mission Sunday collection. Please also return the completed Mission Co-Op evaluation forms; your candid comments are very helpful in deciding which mission groups to invite back to the diocese.

EXTRAORDINARY MISSIONARY MONTH - Pope Francis has called for the month of October, 2019, to be observed worldwide as a time to mark the 100th anniversary of Pope Benedict XV's Apostolic Letter *Maximum Illud*, which emphasized the missionary call to proclaim the Gospel. <u>During the entire month of October</u> this year, in addition to the regular financial collection in support of World Mission Sunday on October 19-20, the Holy Father invites us to a personal encounter with Jesus Christ that moves us to mirror the loving witness exemplified by great missionaries.

Parishes will be receiving promotional resources mailed directly from the publisher in September. In addition, throughout the month of October parishes may wish to include a mission-themed petition in the Mass General Intercessions. Some examples:

For a personal encounter with Jesus Christ that will deepen our passion for Jesus and a passion to share His message with others, near and far, let us pray to the Lord.

For an increase in missionary charity, that our spiritual and financial sacrifices may help the message and love of our Lord be made known to the ends of the earth, let us pray to the Lord.

A suggested bulletin announcement:

Please join Pope Francis in the observance of an Extraordinary Mission Month during October when Catholics worldwide are invited to be aware of the missionary outreach of the Church. Your prayers and financial contributions (especially through the special collection at Masses on Oct. 19-20) will help reinforce the transforming encounter with Christ that is proclaimed through Catholic missionaries all over the world.

As in the past, a World Mission Sunday contribution envelope should be included among the regular parish contribution envelopes your parishioners already have. Also, please do not confuse the World Mission Sunday envelopes with the Mission Co-Op envelopes. Please be cognizant of those volunteers, employees and educators who need to renew their safety training and background checks. Volunteers, Educators and employees are NOT allowed to minister until they are re-certified in the CMGConnect data base. Your cooperation and understanding is greatly appreciated. One final note, please check the CMGConnect data base weekly to be sure everyone in your parish/school has completed the correct trainings/background check and has been properly certified.

2020 MARCH FOR LIFE IN WASHINGTON, D.C. - REGISTRATION DEADLINE SEPTEMBER 30! Time is quickly running out to register for the 2020 March for Life! The 48th Annual March for Life will take place in Washington, D.C. on January 24, 2020. The Salina Diocese sponsored pilgrimage to the march will depart the chancery parking lot Wednesday, January 22, 2020 and will return Sunday, January 26, 2020. A flyer, and a sample bulletin announcement are included with this month's SDNB. Registration forms, Medical/Waiver forms, and Tentative Itinerary are all available on the Diocesan Website.

Basic cost of the trip is \$350, which includes travel and accommodations and the March for Life Rally and March. For an additional cost you may attend the Life is Very Good Rally (+\$20), National Monuments by Moonlight Tour (+\$35), purchase March for Life Swag (+\$9-\$10).
