PROPAGATION OF THE FAITH

2020 MISSION CO-OP: If your parish has not yet had the Mission Co-op appeal for this year, please schedule the appeal at your earliest opportunity that does not conflict with any other diocesan collections, especially for the Holy Land sites (Sept. 12-13, 2020). If you have had the mission Co-op appeal, please forward that collection to the chancery (not the mission group) as soon as possible. Your prompt attention to this will help avoid confusion of the (summer) 2020 Mission Co-op collection with the (October) World Mission Sunday collection. Please also return the completed Mission Co-op evaluation forms. Even if the pastor made the mission Co-op appeal, your candid observations about the mission group are very helpful in deciding which mission groups to invite back to the diocese in the future.

OFFICE OF FAMILY LIFE

ANNIVERSARY MASSES are scheduled for Oct. 18th at Sacred Heart Cathedral in Salina and Oct. 25th at St. Nick's in Hays. The hope is to have the Masses but alternatives to gathering for Mass are also being discussed, including having each couple recognized at their home parish on the weekend of Oct. 25th. A final decision on the best way to recognize and honor couples for being witnesses of God's grace at work in the Sacrament of Marriage will be made by early September and information sent to all parishes.

OFFICE OF RESPECT LIFE

The annual March for Life is January 29th, 2021. The annual pilgrimage from the Diocese of Salina runs January 27th-31st, 2021 but participation may be limited because of the pandemic. Alternate plans are being considered for 2021 including organizing prayer events on the local level. Information on opportunities to participate in this most important event will be made available as soon as definite plans are made.



BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL: Thank you to all for your continued promotion of the Bishop's Annual Appeal. We have \$1,657,771.87 pledged to the appeal! Later this year, we hope to conduct the in-pew

solicitation (watch your emails for details). We will also be sending out letters to people who gave "last year but unfortunately not this" (LYBUNT).

The planning process for the 2021 Annual Appeal is already underway. Katie will be coordinating this. She has been meeting with other annual appeal managers from surrounding dioceses. She also plans to reach out to a few pastors and speak with them. Thank you for working with her on this. Together, we can do so much for the Diocese of Salina.

SEMINARIAN COLLECTION: Thank you to all for your support of the seminarian collection that occurred on August 8-9. We have received tremendous support, both from parish collections as well as from the collection envelope that was included in the most recent issue of Faith magazine.

Please process these donations as you normally would and submit the usual parish check to the Chancery. However, please send the names, addresses and amount given for any parishioners who give \$100.00 or more, to Melanie Melander or Lois Yost.

SEMINARIAN DINNER: As you are aware, the seminarian dinner was canceled this year due to COVID. Instead of the event, the diocese has released videos featuring the seminarians and the Bishop. The response to this has been tremendously generous. We received two \$20,000 matches from anonymous donors, and these are matching all gifts in response to the videos at \$1 to \$1 given until we receive \$40,000. To date, we have received a total of \$57,500. This includes the funds from one anonymous \$20,000 match.

RESPECT LIFE MONTH BABY BOTTLE CAMPAIGNS: Support Catholic Charities Pro-Life Pregnancy and Adoption Programs by holding a Baby Bottle Campaign or another type of fundraiser during Respect Life Month in October. Catholic Charities Pregnancy Program counselors meet monthly with up to 90 pregnant women in the Salina Diocese each month throughout their pregnancy and up to six months post-delivery. The Mobile Outreach Vans travel on Wednesdays each month. The September Mobile Outreach schedule is attached.

2020 CATHOLIC CHARITIES ANNUAL APPEAL: Reminder, the Catholic Charities Annual Appeal has been moved to the second weekend in November, switching places with the Seminarian Appeal. Each priest will receive materials for their parishes in mid-October.

CMGCONNECT- With the start of the new academic year, many volunteers, employees and educators are completing or renewing the training and background checks. Mistakenly, some users are completing the curriculum *video only*, or *background check only*. These curriculums do not meet the full safe environment training for the Diocese of Salina.

When assigning the curriculum to volunteers, educators, and employees please be sure to assign

After assigning this curriculum, please follow up with them and verify in CMGConnect (under Connect Trainings) that they completed the required curriculum. If the required curriculum is not completed when assigned, it could delay the start of their ministry.

KEEPING ON-LINE MINISTRY SAFE AND HOLY: As we continue through this ongoing pandemic, catechists and catholic schoolteachers may be asked to teach remotely. Whether face to face with students or using a digital platform such as zoom, catholic cyberspace must be a safe environment. 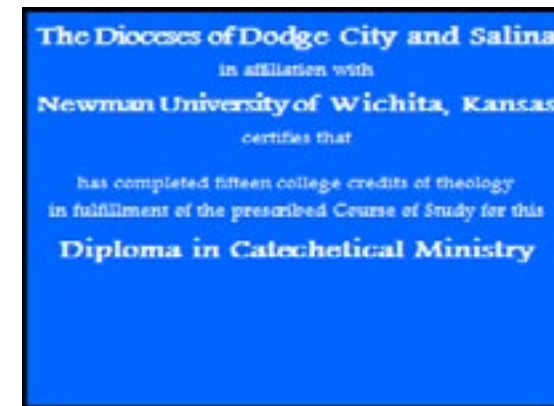

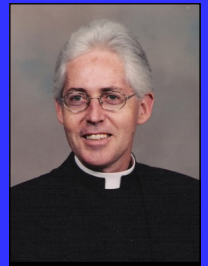

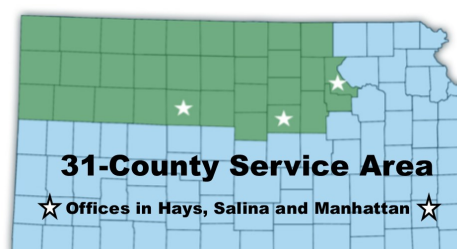

CONSIDER YOUR LOCATION

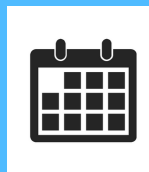
Engage in online forums from public areas of your house-dining room, office space, living room, etc. The backdrop should be free from adult signs or displays

Schedule on-line face-to-face contact with minors in advance through a group forum and with the knowledge and permission of parents or guardians

Avoid sharing personal contact information, instead provide minors with parish or group related email addresses or accounts
