Respecting physical boundaries is one way of showing the dignity and respect that God wants for each of us as God's creation. The more we know about boundary safety the more we can do to protect our children and give to them a lifetime of healthy relationships. Pray for wisdom and guidance to live within your own boundaries. Boundaries are not meant to push others away, boundaries are meant to help hold us together.
