Please note this theme is a change from last month's SDNB. Keynote speaker is Dr. Mario Enzler, former Swiss Guard, and renowned Catholic speaker. Also, share them with men's groups such as K of C, etc. of your parish.

MARRIAGE PREP AND ENRICHMENT CALENDAR OF EVENTS can be found on the diocesan website. The next Engaged Encounter Weekend is scheduled for June 8-10 at the Spiritual Life Center in Victoria. There is still room available for couples so please encourage couples to register immediately. Couples planning Fall 2022 weddings should consider attending the June weekend as the next available weekend in the diocese will not be until the weekend of September 23-25. FOCCUS training will be available later this summer. Priests, deacons or lay persons involved in marriage prep may attend. Date is yet to be decided but plans are for it to be in late July or early August. All parishes and priests will be notified as soon as a date is set.

"VALUE THEM BOTH" Constitutional amendment will be voted on August 2nd in the Kansas Primary election. A YES vote is critical in defending the life and dignity of both women and children in the state of Kansas. Contact Debbie Deneault in the diocesan VTB office to schedule a speaker to visit your parish, order yard signs, bumper stickers, etc. for your parish community, or to find out how you can volunteer to help with the campaign. Parishes should include prayer petitions at every Mass between now and August 2nd and schedule other prayer events such as Exposition/Adoration asking for a favorable outcome.

DIOCESAN ROSARY CONGRESS: The diocese will be participating in the Diocesan Rosary Congress October 1-7. Our Lady of Fatima requested of us to pray the Rosary daily, to offer sacrifices for sinners, and to consecrate ourselves and our families to her Immaculate Heart. The week-long Congress helps the faithful to see that we need this daily prayer in our lives. We NEED 7 parishes to participate, with each parish committing to 24 hours of adoration with a Rosary being prayed each hour before the Blessed Sacrament. OFFICE OF EDUCATION

SCHOOL YEAR: The 2021-2022 school year is in the books! There were 2,281 students enrolled in our Catholic schools this year, including 94 high school graduates. We also were able to award 29 new students in grades K-8 with scholarships from the Scholarship Granting Fund for the Catholic Diocese of Salina. Please visit the link above to learn more about qualifications, and to apply for the next school year.

ACCREDITATION: Our official review from the accreditation agency, Cognia, was received recently. The review exceeded our expectations, as 81% of the standards measured were rated at the highest level. We are working on a press release for community newspapers in the coming weeks to showcase our success.

ASSESSMENTS: Students all finished up state assessments this spring, and our schools performed well on the standardized tests. School leaders and teachers will use the data to help improve instruction for the next school year.

SUMMER ENGAGEMENT: Some of our schools are able to host summer programs to help keep students engaged in learning and to build healthy relationships with one another.

LUNCH PROGRAM: The federal lunch program, which has been free to ALL students the last two school years has been discontinued. Families will have to pay for lunches based on household economic income.

SAFETY COORDINATORS: Please continue to monitor your CMGConnect database through the summer months, especially those parishes and schools who continue to have summer programs for our youth. We will not have an on-site audit this year, but it is imperative that I have accurate records, as I will still need to submit our diocesan data to our auditors. Please archive users who are not ministering and contact users who need to update. Continuing this process during the summer will make for easier "paperwork" this fall. In addition to monitoring your database, please continue to check your email for other important information from the Safe Environment Office.

MANDATORY MICROSOFT TEAMS MEETING: Microsoft Team Meetings for Parish/School Safety Coordinators will be scheduled this summer in lieu of the Fall Safety Coordinator Newsletter. Microsoft Team Meetings for Safety Coordinators of schools will tentatively be scheduled late July, and Safety Coordinators of parishes, late July and early August. An email will be forthcoming with exact dates and times. Note: You can attend a Teams meeting even if you do not have a Teams account. I will send directions with your email invitation.



Online social media services aren't new, but many of us are still learning how to use them without getting into trouble – especially children and teens. Use these tips to help your kids safely use any social media service from networking to image posting sites.

Do you know...



What they're posting?

Check comments and images for personal information, like phone numbers and addresses, as well as inappropriate and illegal content such as hateful or threatening speech and nudity. Delete anything you think is too much information.



How they access social media?

Mobile devices, like cell phones and tablets, let children access social media apps away from adult supervision. Children may post content and even share their locations. Review app settings to help them keep information – like their location – private.



Who they're talking to?

Your child's online contact lists and followers may include people you don't know, or even people your child only knows online. Even if you don't know the contact, make sure you know what images, messages, and other content they're sharing.



What account settings they're using?

This is where you can control who has access to your child's information. Each social media service has a different setup, so take a look at each one your child uses. Always ask yourself – what is on the profile and who can see it?



Who has access to their information?

Most social media services have ads and applications from 3rd parties, like games and fan pages. If children click on these or add them to their profiles, they are allowing access to their personal information. Have a discussion about what's OK to add and what's not.



Where to report?

If anyone talks to your child about sex, shares or asks them to share sexual images, or is a victim of sexual exploitation, make a report to the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children® at www.CyberTipline.com or 1-800-THE-LOST®.
