DIOCESAN ROSARY CONGRESS: The diocese will be participating in the Diocesan Rosary Congress October 1st-7th. BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL: As of 8/18/22, we have \$1,925,321.63 pledged from 3214 donors. We are 96.3% towards the goal. The donors who gave last year but not yet this year, have recently received a letter asking them to make a gift. Thank you for continuing to promote the appeal in your parish bulletin, updating your poster and in the Prayers of the Faithful. We have already begun asset design for the 2023 appeal!

SEMINARIAN EVENTS: As you are aware, we had two dinners this year, one in Salina and one in Hays. The extra effort was worth it as over 300 people attended the events! Additionally, we had a match of \$105,000. Any gift made to the dinner, collection or seminarian education fund in general is matched \$1 for \$1 while funds remain. They were great events where we were able to meet the seminarians, their families and supporters.

CATHOLIC GIFT ANNUITIES: Did you know there is a way to continue your legacy of support and give yourself life-long income? You can do this by establishing a Catholic Gift Annuity (CGA) benefiting your parish, school, or any program within the Diocese of Salina.

Here is how it works- If you are between 55 and 80, you can make a generous gift to Catholic Gift Annuity (minimum \$5,000), and in return, you receive a tax deduction in the year you make your gift. Then, you or a loved one will begin receiving steady, fixed payments from Catholic Gift Annuity (Administered by Catholic Extension) for the rest of your life. At the end of your lifetime, any remaining funds will be given to the Diocesan entity you name in your agreement. It could be your parish, school, Seminarian Education, or any ministry under the Diocese. Your payout rate will be based on your age at the time you establish the Charitable Gift Annuity with us.
