CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH is quickly approaching. It is a time to act collectively to raise awareness and empower people across our diocese to play a role in making great childhoods happen. Last year, as a Chancery Staff we raised awareness by wearing blue (a symbol of hope and heavenly grace) on April 7th and recited a Rosary for the healing and protection of all who have been affected by child abuse. After the Rosary Bishop Vincke shared the story of St. Maria Goretti, patron saint of youth, young women, purity, and victims of rape. #IGIVECATHOLIC: The Diocese of Salina raised over \$717,000! We are so excited about the results and hope that you are as well. We appreciate everyone's efforts in making this successful, and we're looking forward to the 2023 campaign. Some quick stats regarding our 2022 campaign-

- The Diocese of Salina ranked 10th overall out of 42 participating dioceses.
- We had 1,140 donors this year – an increase over last year.
- 2 organizations finished in the top 50 of all participating organizations – St. Andrew Grade School in Abilene was 26th in the country and Manhattan Catholic Schools was 39th.
