As you embark on yet another new school year, please begin contacting all new employees and volunteers, those employees and volunteers who were archived and want to continue ministering, and those employees and volunteers who need to renew the Safe Environment protocol, as soon as possible. Training and background checks must be completed before beginning ministry.

TAX CREDIT SCHOLARSHIP INCREASES TO 75% STATE TAX CREDIT: The State of Kansas has increased the tax credit a donor can receive from 70% to 75% for this year. For the past two years, the [Scholarship Granting Fund for the Catholic Diocese of Salina](#) has been able to award almost \$250,000 to students to help cover the costs of education. 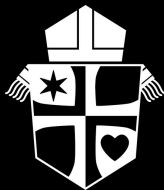
