**CLERGY RENEWAL DAYS, JANUARY 15 – 18, 2024** - Our annual Salina Diocese Clergy Renewal Days will be from Monday, January 15<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, January 18<sup>th</sup> at the Spiritual Life Center in Wichita.
