**BOX OF JOY:** The Catholic schools along with many parishes are participating in Cross Catholic Outreach's Box of Joy service project. Over 1,300 boxes were distributed in communities across the diocese, and we are awaiting their return. These boxes will be shipped to Florida where they will have a rosary and a *Story of Jesus* booklet packed into each box. The Boxes of Joy will then be sent to areas of need across the world for boys and girls to open on Christmas.

**CATHOLIC SCHOOLS & CATHOLIC CHARITIES PARTNERSHIP**: Students and staff at our Catholic schools donated over \$13,000 worth of diapers to Catholic Charities of Northern Kansas. Schools brought their collected diapers to the annual Teachers' Institute on Friday, November 10, where they were greeted by students from St. Mary's Grade School and Sacred Heart Jr/Sr High School, as well as staff from Catholic Charities.
