PRAYER FOR LIFE KANSAS - Plans are underway for the Second Annual Prayer for Life Kansas. This will include a Rosary Procession around Capitol Square in Topeka on Friday, April 26th, 2024, at 2pm. On April 26th, 2019, the Kansas Supreme Court held in Hodes & Nauser MDs v. Schmidt that the Kansas Constitution protects the "natural" right to abortion. We are excited to join with other dioceses across Kansas in prayer for the end to the legalization of Abortion in our state.

NATIONAL CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK (CSW) January 28 – February 3 - is an annual celebration of Catholic education in the United States that was started in 1974. Schools typically observe the week with Masses, assemblies, and other activities for students, families, parishioners, and community members to celebrate. Through these events, schools focus on the value Catholic education provides to young people and its contributions to our church, our communities, and our nation. This year's theme is Catholic Schools: Faith. Excellence. Service. Bishop Vincke will be celebrating Mass with all the students throughout the week in our communities.

KAIRS EDUCATOR OF THE YEAR FOR THE SALINA DIOCESE - Chris Whitehair, Principal – St. Andrew's in Abilene, was named the recipient of the KAIRS Educator of the Year for the Salina Diocese. 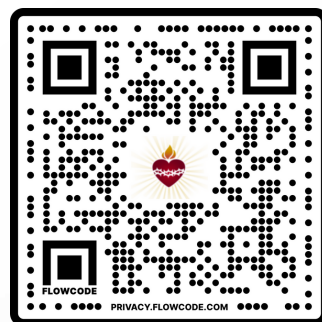
