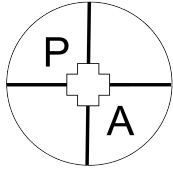

If you have not turned in your medical and permission forms you will need to do so **no later than May 1**. They must be in before you attend the mission. If you have **not** turned in your forms by the Wednesday before your work week, please **do not** put them in the mail. Take them with you to the registration location and give them to the Prayer and Action team.

We have also included a checklist of items that should be brought on the trip. They include:

1. A water bottle
2. Work clothes (something appropriate to paint in), all shirts must have sleeves. *Remember there is a lot of sweat work and no laundry facilities.*
3. Recreational clothes
4. Towel
5. Sun screen
6. Notebook/journal to write in with a writing utensil
7. Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, sanitary items, etc)
8. Recreational activities (playing cards, frisbees, footballs, etc)
9. Snack food (we recommend that this be kept together in some sort of a labeled container for your group)
10. Sleeping bag (a blow up mattress would also be ok)
11. Pillow

We will make efforts to make the showers as private as possible, and we will also have separate times in which the students and the adult leaders will be able to shower. However, if a student would like to have even more privacy, we recommend they bring a bathing suit to shower in.

We would also like to ask you to bring a few supplies such as paint brushes, scrapers, plant snipers, hedge trimmers, and maybe a few other common tools. *(For painting and yard work)* Each group may also bring with them a few snacks for the students to eat should they get hungry between meals or during their free time.

Our daily schedule is as follows:

7:00 a.m.	Wake up and meet for morning reflections
7:30	Mass and Rosary
8:30	Breakfast and prepare sack lunches
9:15	Travel to work sites and begin work
12:00	Eat lunch at work site
3:30	Clean up and leave work site
4:00	Showers and free time
4:45	Dinner preparations
5:00	Adult leader meeting
5:30	Dinner
7:00	Evening activity
8:00	Collatio (Large group, skit, prayer, and worship time)
9:15	Parish group time followed by free time
11:00	Night prayer
11:15	Lights out!
